Words Have Power

<u>AIDET</u> is a quick, effective way to connect with others. Here's how it works:

- » Acknowledge the person with eye contact and a smile
- » Introduce yourself
- » Share the **Duration** of what to expect
- » Explain what you're doing and why
- » Thank the person

Address Concerns With A-HEART

Great service recovery starts with A-HEART. Here's how:

- » Apologize for the experience
- » Hear what the person is saying
- » Empathize with the person's feelings
- » Ask how you can help
- » Resolve the issue if you can
- » Thank the person
