Total Health Assessment (THA) Quick Start Guide



Before you begin, it's helpful, although not required, to have the following information on hand: height, weight, waist measurement, immunization history, blood pressure, cholesterol, and glucose (blood sugar). See below for instructions on "How to Find Your Health Information on kp.org."

STEP 1: Go to http://kp.org/hwf. Click Take the THA for KP Health Plan Members.

NOTE: If you are a benefited employee but you are not a Kaiser Permanente member (you get your health coverage elsewhere), click **Take the THA for non-KP Health Plan Members**, and follow the directions.

STEP 2: Enter your member kp.org sign-on information if you're not already logged on.

NOTE: This is not your NUID. Instructions are provided if you do not know your kp.org sign on or don't have one.

STEP 3: Follow the directions on the page. This will vary depending on whether you are taking the THA for the first time, retaking it or finishing one you started.

STEP 4: After completing the THA questionnaire, click on Certificate of Completion (in your Plan links) to confirm that you have completed the THA.

Congratulations! You took an important step in your health and wellness plan, and helped eligible employees in our region meet the first gate in the Total Health Incentive Plan.

How to Find Your Health Information on KP.org

STEP 1: If you are a KP member, go to **kp.org** and sign on using your member log-on info, or register for log-on information.

STEP 2: Click on My Medical Record. (under My Health Manager tab).

STEP 3: Find your numbers:

- » Select Past visit information (on the left side of the page) to find weight, height, and blood pressure readings from your most recent doctor visit.
- » Select Test results if you've had your cholesterol, triglycerides or blood sugar measured.
- » Select Immunizations to see your immunization history.

STEP 4: Record your numbers.
